

ANGELS: MESSENGERS OF GOD

Did God create angels?
Scripture says, "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth." (Genesis 1:1) The Church in her profession of faith proclaims that God is the Creator of everything, visible and invisible, of all spiritual and physical beings.⁷ This includes angels, humans and even thought, time and space.

Who are the angels?
The angels are purely spiritual creatures, intangible, invisible, immortal, and personal beings endowed with intelligence and will. They see God face-to-face and they glorify him. They serve him and are his messengers in the accomplishment of his saving mission to all.⁸

What was the fall of the angels?
Satan and the other demons were originally angels, created good by God. They, however, freely chose to reject God and his Kingdom, thus giving rise to the existence of hell.⁹

What are angels?
Angels are pure spirit beings created by God to do his will. The word angel means 'messenger'. Angels do not have a physical body; however they do have understanding and free will. They are spiritual beings that are inferior to God but superior to humans. Scripture speaks of the three Archangels by name: Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael.¹⁰

Does everyone have a guardian angel?
Yes, our guardian angel is always by our side to protect us and help us get to heaven.¹¹ Our guardian angels help us by praying for us and inspiring us to do good.

Going deeper
God created all that exists from 'out of nothing'. Science cannot explain how the universe was created from absolutely nothing, no light, no matter, no energy, no electrons, no mass, no gravity. Only God can do that. All scientific explanations start with some sort of matter or energy to begin with. Everything has a cause; objects do not bring themselves into existence. God is the only possible original cause of all that is seen and unseen. St Thomas Aquinas said that God is an uncaused cause and the unmoved mover.¹² Therefore, something caused the Universe to exist, and this First Cause must be God.
